## SHARING THE BLESSINGS OF EID & FEEDING HUMANITY

Every year, Muslims around the world celebrate Eid-ul-Adha during the Islamic month of Dhul Hijjah. On the days of Eid-ul-Adha, halal animals are sacrificed to commemorate the Sunnah of Prophet Ibrahim (AS), and the meat is distributed among impoverished and needy communities. Qurbani animals vary depending on the region, but typically include cows, goats, camels and sheep.

**Islam emphasises everybody coming together, and especially the inclusion of the poor and vulnerable people.** As Muslims, we firmly believe that no one should be left behind. The season of Qurbani is an important time to reflect on self-sacrifice, as demonstrated by Prophet Ibrahim (AS), and our own connection to Allah (SWT).

In 2025, Muslim Charity carried out **28,127 Qurbanis** across **13 countries**, ensuring your sacrifices reached the most vulnerable communities with dignity and care. Together, we delivered a powerful message of compassion during Eid-ul-Adha, here's what your support helped achieve:

# WHY FRESH MEAT DISTRIBUTION IS NEEDED, AND ITS BENEFITS TO VULNERABLE FAMILIES

Other than disparity between poor and rich, urban and rural setting war, civil unrest, climate change, economic growth and displacement are the biggest factors in global food crisis.

Muslim Charity's Qurbani distributions helped families living in abject poverty, by not only spreading the joy of Eid but also providing fresh and nutritious meat. Many families are unable to buy meat throughout the year, and this often affects their diets, leaving them without important nutrients such as iron and protein. Our Qurbani distributions have truly helped people in building their health and immune systems, helping to keep them healthier for longer.



ACCORDING TO STATISTICS, NEARLY **700 MILLION PEOPLE** (8.5% OF THE GLOBAL POPULATION) LIVE IN EXTREME POVERTY, ON LESS THAN **£1.50 PER DAY**.

ACCORDING TO THE WORLD FOOD PROGRAMME, **343 MILLION PEOPLE FACE ACUTE HUNGER**.



# WHY FRESH MEAT DISTRIBUTION IS NEEDED



## NUTRITIONAL VALUE

Fresh meat is rich in protein, iron, zinc, and essential vitamins (B12), crucial for growth, development, and immunity. Many low-income families can't afford these nutrient-rich foods regularly.



## HEALTH INEQUALITY

Poor nutrition contributes to health issues such as anaemia, fatigue, delayed development in children and weakened immunity. Providing fresh meat helps bridge the health gap for at-risk communities.



## FOOD INSECURITY

Vulnerable households often rely on donations, access to fresh, high-quality proteins like meat is rare but vital for maintaining a balanced diet.



## RELIGIOUS SIGNIFICANCE

Offering fresh meat is also a way to share and celebrate Eid-ul-Adha, honour sacred traditions, and help vulnerable families maintain their dignity.



## MUSLIM CHARITY'S PROJECT DELIVERY MECHANISM

To effectively & efficiently deliver Qurbani meat, we established Community Groups comprising local leaders such as school and madrassah teachers, mosque Imams and partner organisation members. The Community Groups were involved in every stage of the Qurbani process and distribution, including the procurement of animals, ensuring compliance with Islamic principles, selecting distribution points, identifying beneficiary and monitoring of the meat distribution.

The beneficiaries were selected based on their economic circumstances, and priority was given to the most vulnerable groups including:

Specified distribution points were allocated where those receiving Qurbani meat would come to collect their meat. Furthermore, our teams' hand-delivered Qurbani meat to those who were unable to reach the distribution points, such as those with illnesses, disabilities or age-related factors.



## CASE STUDY: NEPAL

Meet Brother Moharram from Nepal, a father of seven children, who lives in extreme poverty with his family of nine. Born with a disability that affects one of his lower limbs, he relies on a wheelchair for mobility. With no stable income or shelter, his daily life revolves around begging in the streets just to survive.

He was one of our Qurbani meat distribution beneficiaries and expressed his feelings of joy and happiness.

*"We are homeless and sometimes sleep without food. Fresh meat during Qurbani is beyond our imagination. I came here by wheelchair to receive the meat. Thanks to Muslim Charity UK, this meat will feed my family for one whole week. In' shaa Allah, next year I hope to receive help again".*

Moharram's story demonstrates how a simple act of kindness can have a profound impact on the lives of the most vulnerable families



## THE IMPACT

Distributing Qurbani meat has truly helped vulnerable people experience the joy and celebration of Eid-ul-Adha. Together, we ensured that no one was left out, and that everyone was able to eat wholesome, nutritious meat during the blessed days.

Our Qurbani process is all done locally. We work with local vendors to procure and transport animals, as well as to carry out slaughter, packing and distribution, This means that we create jobs for many people, including butchers, farmers and drivers. We help boost local economies, creating lasting change that will help communities for over time.
