Executive Summary

YOUR IMPACT IN 2026

Every year, Muslims around the world celebrate Eid-ul-Adha in the Islamic month of Dhul Hijjah. To commemorate the Sunnah of Prophet Ibrahim (AS), halal animals—including cows, goats, camels, and sheep—are sacrificed, and the meat is distributed among impoverished and needy communities.

Islam emphasises community and the explicit inclusion of poor and vulnerable people. As Muslims, we truly believe that nobody should be left behind. The season of Qurbani is an important time to reflect on self-sacrifice, as demonstrated by Prophet Ibrahim (AS), and our own connection to Allah (SWT).

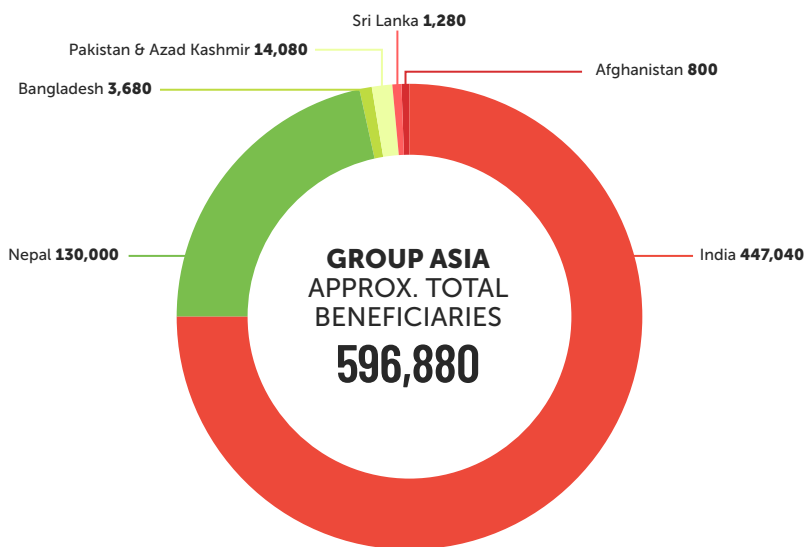

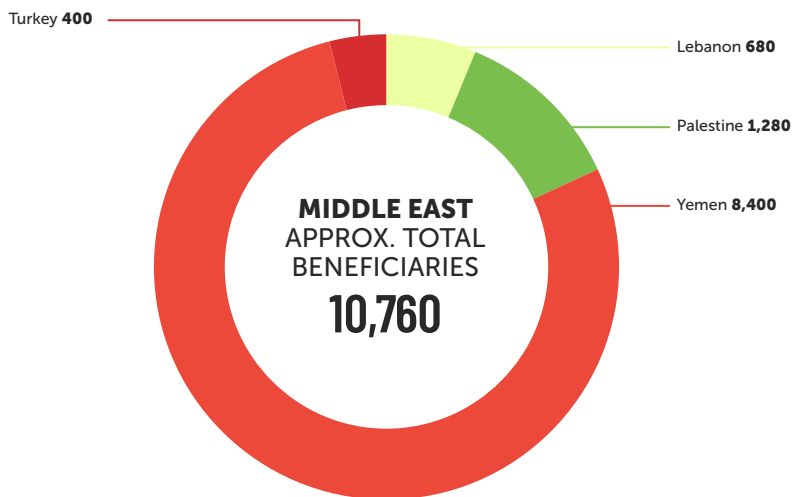

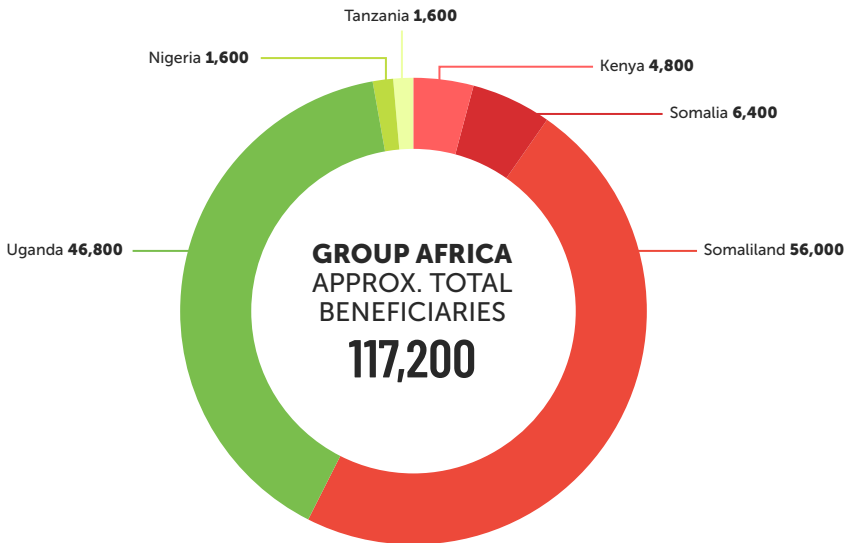

Why is Fresh Meat Distribution Needed & How Does It Benefit Vulnerable Families?

In addition to disparities between rich and poor communities and urban and rural settings, war, civil unrest, climate change, displacement and economic instability are among the biggest contributors to the global food crisis.

Muslim Charity's Qurbani distributions helped families living in abject poverty, both with spreading the joy of Eid and by providing fresh and nutritious meat. Many families are unable to buy meat throughout the whole year, and this often affects their diets, leaving them without important nutrients such as iron and protein. Our Qurbani distributions have truly helped people in building their health and immune systems, helping to keep them healthier for longer.

The Benefits of Fresh Meat Distribution



NUTRITIONAL VALUE

Fresh meat is a rich source of protein, iron, zinc, and essential vitamins (like B12), which are crucial for growth, development, and immune function. Many low-income families cannot afford these nutrient-dense foods regularly.



FOOD INSECURITY

Vulnerable households often rely on donations. Access to fresh, high-quality proteins like meat is rare but vital for their balanced diet.



HEALTH INEQUALITY

Poor nutrition contributes to health issues such as anaemia, fatigue, delayed development in children and weakened immunity. Providing fresh meat helps bridge the health gap for at-risk communities.



RELIGIOUS SIGNIFICANCE

Offering fresh meat is also a way to share and celebrate Eid-ul-Adha, honour sacred traditions, and help vulnerable families maintain their dignity.

Muslim Charity's Project Delivery Mechanism

In order to effectively and efficiently deliver Qurbani meat, we established Community Groups which included local leaders such as school and madrassah teachers, Mosque Imams and partner organisation members. The Community Groups were involved in every stage of the Qurbani and distribution, including the procurement of animals, ensuring compliance with Islamic principles, selection of distribution points, beneficiary selection and monitoring of the meat distribution.

The beneficiaries were selected based on their economic circumstances, and priority was given to the most vulnerable groups including:



Women-headed households



Families with orphan children & elderly.



Families living with special needs persons

Specified distribution points were allocated where those receiving Qurbani meat would come in order to collect their meat.

Furthermore, our teams' hand-delivered meat to those people who were unable to reach the distribution points, such as those with illnesses, disabilities or age-related factors.



The Impact

Distributing Qurbani meat has really helped vulnerable people feel the joy and celebrations of Eid-ul-Adha. Together we helped ensure that nobody was left out, and that everybody was able to eat wholesome, nutritious meat across the blessed days.

Our Qurbani process is all done locally. We use local vendors to procure and transport animals, as well as during the slaughter, packing and distribution processes. This means that we create jobs for many people including butchers, farmers and drivers. We help boost local economies, creating bigger change that will help communities for longer.
